

FIERACAVALLI VERONA 2010

1st EUROPEAN CRIOLLO HORSE MORPHOLOGICAL COMPETITION

General Regulations:

Owners of horses who intend to take part in the competition must hold due and valid registration for the current year (ANACC enrolment – Breeder / Sustaining member except for international participants).

- Riders must provide the Competition Secretariat with riding authorisation issued by an Authority recognised by CONI (Italian Olympic Committee) or equivalent depending on the country of origin.
- Every horse enrolled must be in possession of a due pedigree certificate issued by one of the Associations Recognised by / Belonging to FICCC.
- Every horse taking part must have due and valid anti-influenza vaccinations and contagious equine anaemia test (**Coggin's test: essential for access by horses to the Exhibition Centre**).

General regulations for Enrolments:

- Pre-enrolment is compulsory and the Association reserves the right of accept enrolments received after the pre-enrolment term.
- Pre-enrolment involves returning a box booking form (available through www.anacc.it, or www.fieracavalli.it or attached to these regulations in pdf format) together with the deposit of € **100.00** by **15 September 2010**
- All procedures concerning the Competition and the consignment of necessary documents must be completed through the Secretariat no later than the day prior to the start of the event.
- The payment of sums due, the balance of the box cost (€ **260.00 + VAT**) and enrolments must be completed by **10 October 2010**; non-payment involves automatic exclusion from the competition.
- The cost of enrolment for the various horse classes taking part is € **50.00**

The horse classes involved are subject to variations in relation to the number of enrolments.

For the *potrillos* and *potrancas* classes, horses may be conducted at the halter and riders must enter the ring in gaucho outfits.

For the remaining classes, horses may compete with typical South American harnessing and riders must wear gaucho outfits; horses and riders shall enter the ring in groups of eight (or fewer in relation to the number of participants). They must tour the ring once at a walk, once at a trot and once at a gallop and then stop in front of the jury. The riders will dismount and exhibit their horses one at a time conducted at a walk and, if so requested by the jury, also at a trot.

Scores and rankings:

Scores will be awarded and rankings defined by a jury comprising three judges from Argentina, Uruguay and Brazil (we are waiting to receive their names from the respective Associations).

Awards:

The first three horses in the ranking for each class will receive awards.

Potrillos: percentage of income from enrolments + any prizes added by sponsors

Padrillo Menor: percentage of income from enrolments + any prizes added by sponsors

Padrillo Mayor: percentage of income from enrolments + any prizes added by sponsors

Potrancas: percentage of income from enrolments + any prizes added by sponsors

- Show Entry fee: €50
- Deadline for registration: September 10, 2010 (with copy of payment €100 in favour of ANACC - Italy -ASSOCIAZIONE NAZIONALE ALLEVATORI CAVALLO CRIOLO- BANCA POPOLARE DI SONDRIO- IBAN: IT23 N056 9601 6130 0000 8059 X01 - fax n. 1782766553
